Text From Source: A NEWPORT POISONING CASE  
A married woman named Fanny Clissett, living with her husband in East Market-street, Newport, has been admitted to the Newport Infirmary suffering severely from poison, supposed to have been self-administered late on Saturday night. She was in an unconscious condition. It was not ascertained what character poison she had taken, but with the administration of the stomach pump a good deal of relief was afforded, and she is now progressing favourably. It is stated that the woman had attempted suicide twice before. Mrs Clissett, who is about 24 years of age, has only been married about three months. She

came from London, and, since her marriage, has occasionally assisted her husband in his trade as a repairer of chairs.
